### ANIMAL (PIG) RESEARCH ASSOCIATED HEALTH RISKS

General precautions include good hygiene practices, being aware of your surroundings, using appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE), asking questions, and reporting incidents/injuries. **For all incidents, notify your supervisor immediately and complete an Initial Report on Work Related Injury or Illness form. Potential Hazards	Appropriate Precautions
<b>Anesthetic Gases</b>	• Appropriately scavenge gas waste. <i>Isflurane is a reproductive hazard.</i>
<b>Animal Allergies</b>	• Use PPE and know common symptoms, such as breathing difficulty, sneezing, itchy eyes, runny nose, or a rash/hives when in contact with animals.
<b>Animal Bites/Scratches</b>	• Know species behavior and use proper handling/restraint techniques and PPE.
<b>Environmental Hazards</b>	• Request training before using new equipment or performing unfamiliar tasks. • Report potential hazards to supervisor and exercise caution in areas of known risk.
<b>Needle Sticks</b>	• Do not recap needles. Follow <a href="#">OSHA Universal Precautions</a> . • Cleanse wound with soap and water and irrigate area; report at UHS 513-584-STIX.
<b>Zoonotic Diseases (Zoonoses)</b>	• Zoonoses are diseases that can be passed from animals to humans. • Contact with feral animals or random source carnivores, and exposure to pregnant ruminants increase risk of zoonoses. Zoonoses for pig species includes swine flu.
