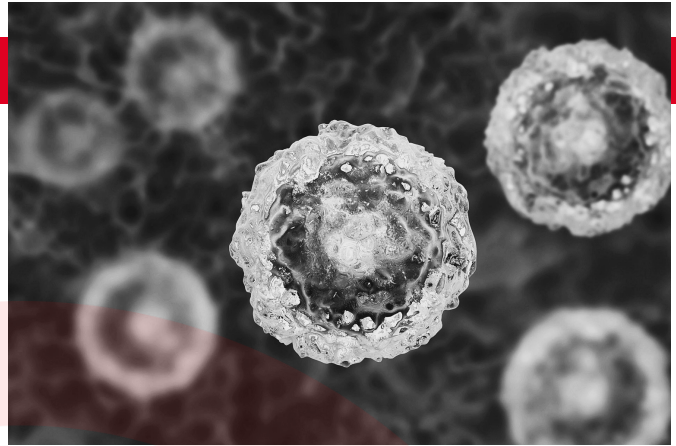




IBC / Human Pluripotent Stem Cells Prohibited Activities

No UC personnel shall engage in, and no UC facilities, equipment or other resources shall be utilized for any of the following activities:



- *In vitro* culture of intact human embryos, regardless of method of creation, beyond 14 days or after formation of the primitive streak begins, whichever occurs first.
- Creation of an embryo by fertilization solely to donate to research.
- Implanting a chimeric embryo containing non-human cells, including embryonic stem cells, into the uterus of a human.
- Introduction of human pluripotent cells into human blastocysts.
- Breeding of animals that have had human pluripotent cells introduced at any stage of development (including the germ line).
- Human reproductive cloning
