

Office of Research Research Launch Awards for First- Year Faculty

Eligibility:

- Have joined UC Faculty on August 15, 2018
- You are a Full time professor in one of the following position titles: tenure track, educator track, research track, clinical track, or professional practice
- Attend at least 5 workshops per semester in each of the coming Fall and Spring semesters for faculty hired on or before August 15, 2018
- Attend at least 5 workshops per semester in each of the coming Spring and Fall semesters for faculty hired after August 15, 2018

Receive \$2,500 in professional development funds for research in the Summer of 2019 from the Office of Research



Office of Research Research Launch Awards for First- Year Faculty

(Alternative Option)

Eligibility:

- Have joined UC Faculty on August 15, 2018
- You are a Full time professor in one of the following position titles: tenure track, educator track, research track, clinical track, or professional practice
- Participation on Office of Research Standing Review Panel for internal awards PLUS attend at least 6 workshops over the 18-19 academic year. Call for interest will be distributed next week.

Receive \$3,500 in professional development funds for research in the Summer of 2019 from the Office of Research
